1 Peter 4:10

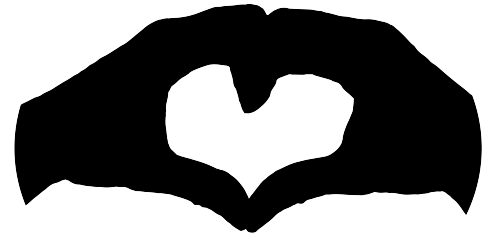
